Scholarship to the 2010 MEDIA ARTS ACADEMY FOR TEENS

**Deadline: June 1, 2010**

The Frank Hood Scholarship, established in 1987, honors Oregon filmmaker and industry leader, Frank Hood, founder of Teknifilm, Inc. and mentor to many young people entering the field.

**One individual will be selected to receive a Frank Hood Scholarship in the amount of \$1095.** The award will be directly applied to tuition for the Media Arts Academy for Teens, a career exploration boot camp for those interested in film school or a career in the moving image arts.

The Scholarship is made possible by the Frank Hood Fund of the Oregon Community Foundation, and is administered by the Northwest Film Center in cooperation with members of the Frank Hood family.

Eligibility and Selection

Applicants must be Oregon residents, 18 years of age or younger, and have a strong interest in film or video. Previous experience in film or video production experience is preferred but not required. Enrollment in school at the time of application is optional.

Priority will be given to those who have demonstrated a high degree of commitment in their studies so far, and who clearly articulate their future goals in film.

A panel of professional filmmakers and members of the Frank Hood family will review scholarship applications. Finalists may be called for personal interviews. Scholarship winners will be asked to attend a brief public ceremony at which they will be recognized on a future date to be determined.
